**WELL INCIDENT AT HABANERO 3**

Geodynamics as operator of the Innamincka Joint Venture today advised of a well incident at its Habanero 3 well site, located near Innamincka in remote South Australia.

Geodynamics Managing Director Gerry Grove-White said, "Importantly no-one has been injured and the site has been secured to ensure the safety of personnel and the public".

At 8:30pm local time on 24 April 2009 (9pm AEST) a loud noise was heard and it was identified that water and steam were flowing to the surface at the Habanero 3 well head.

"Geodynamics is taking the matter extremely seriously and we have today mobilised an expert well control recovery team, comprising specialist engineers," Mr Grove-White said.

Geodynamics is working with relevant authorities in response to this event and will provide further updates as they become available.
